## Calef Lake Campground Covid-19 Policies

As part of our commitment to keep guests and staff safe while complying with state and local executive orders, Calef Lake Campground will implement the following policies effective immediately.

- Only Online reservations will be accepted. No in person reservations will be taken until Monday 6/15/20.
- If any guest, as part of your reservation, are feeling sick please do not come.
- Registered Guests must practice social distancing and family groups must stay 6ft apart while visiting the campground. A limit of 10 people per site will be enforced.
- Campsite rentals will be limited to registered guests only until Monday 6/15/20. No large gatherings or outside guests will be allowed on the campsites.
- The Camp Store will have limited hours (posted on the door) and be open utilizing window service only.
  - Firewood and Ice can be purchased during store hours
    - Firewood can be delivered to campsites upon request.
- The beach area will be open as of Friday 6/5/20 for swimming and active recreation only.
  - Swimming is limited to the extent swimmers can maintain 6ft separation. If this cannot be maintained, please come back at a different time to swim. Upon exiting the water, swimmers must return to their campsites to allow others to swim.
  - Young swimmers (under 16) must be accompanied by an adult for the duration of their swim. Adults not swimming must remain in motion and maintain 6ft separation from others on the beach.
  - o There is no sitting or socializing within the beach area. Only single family groups can swim together.
  - It will be the Adults responsibility to follow these beach rules. Failure to follow these rules could result in the beach area being closed to everyone for the day.
- Boat Rentals will be closed to all guests until Monday 6/15/20.
- The playgrounds are open to single family groups only. Children must be supervised and 6ft of separation maintained. Children should utilize gloves while handling playground equipment.
- The main bathrooms and the bathrooms behind the laundry room will open on Friday 6/5/20. **All guests who have bathrooms in their campers are urged to utilize them during their stay.** 
  - Bathroom will be cleaned and sanitized daily. In addition, there will be a sanitizing spray bottle in each bathroom – we encourage guests to mist surfaces touched after use as a courtesy to others who will need to use these after you.
- Campground recreational activities will be limited based upon social distancing guidelines. Please see weekly postings at the store for the schedule.
- Guests are encouraged to utilize our online portal to Check-in and pay their outstanding balances prior to arrival. Check-in packets for guests will be located on a table outside the store (weather permitting) or on the camp store door. If you have a balance upon arrival, please Check-in at the walk-up window of the Camp Store.
- Parking lots located at the entrance (outside the gate) of the campground will be closed until 6/15/20 since no outside guests are allowed to visit the campground. Seasonal guests should plan to park on their sites (2 car max with plate numbers on file) Transient guests are allowed 1 vehicle per reservation and should only park on their site. In order to comply with State and town requirements this will be strictly enforced.
- The campground gate will be closed until further notice. Please lift and lower the gate gently when entering or leaving the campground.

As always, we want our guests to have a safe and enjoyable time while visiting us.
