Calef Lake Campground Covid-19 Policies

As part of our commitment to keep guests and staff safe while complying with state and local executive orders, Calef Lake Campground will implement the following policies effective immediately.

- Only Online reservations will be accepted. No in person reservations will be taken until Monday 6/15/20.
- If any guest, as part of your reservation, are feeling sick please do not come.
- Out of state Guests will be required to sign attestation of 14 day stay at home prior to arrival.
- Registered Guests must practice social distancing and family groups must stay 6ft apart while visiting the campground. A limit of 10 people per site will be enforced.
- Campsite rentals will be limited to registered guests only until further notice. No large gatherings or outside guests will be allowed on the campsites.
- The Camp Store will have limited hours (posted on the door) and be open utilizing window service only.
 - Only Firewood and Ice can be purchased during store hours.
 - o Retail sales may open soon, please review your packet during check-in for the latest information.
- The beach area will be open as of Friday 6/5/20.
 - Swimming is limited to the extent swimmers can maintain 6ft separation between family groups. If this
 cannot be maintained, please come back at a different time.
 - Beach area can be utilized but each family group must maintain 6ft from other groups. If this cannot be maintained, please come back at a different time.
 - o Young swimmers (under 16) must be accompanied by an adult for the duration of their swim.
 - It will be the Adults responsibility to follow these beach rules.
- Boat Rentals are available by appointment only starting 6/15/20. Boats, paddles and Life jackets will be sanitized between rentals. Please call the store to schedule a rental.
- The playgrounds are closed until further notice. Playgrounds may open soon so please call the office for up to date information.
- The main bathrooms and the bathrooms behind the laundry room will open on Friday 6/5/20. All guests who have bathrooms in their campers are urged to utilize them during their stay.
 - Bathroom will be cleaned and sanitized daily.
- Campground recreational activities will be limited based upon social distancing guidelines. Please see weekly
 postings at the store for the schedule.
- Guests are encouraged to utilize our online portal to Check-in and pay their outstanding balances prior to arrival. Check-in packets for guests will be located on a table outside the store (weather permitting) or on the camp store door. If you have a balance upon arrival, please Check-in at the walk-up window of the Camp Store.
- Parking lots located at the entrance (outside the gate) of the campground will be closed until further notice. No
 outside guests are allowed to visit the campground. Seasonal guests should plan to park on their sites (2 car max
 with plate numbers on file) Transient guests are allowed 1 vehicle per reservation (second car can be purchased)
 and should only park on their site. In order to comply with State and town requirements this will be strictly
 enforced.
- The campground gate will be closed until further notice. Please lift and lower the gate gently when entering or leaving the campground.
